Operation People for Peace, Inc. has also met with the Indian Americans that have expressed that out of more than a dozen meetings with Ken Feinberg/BP, Feinberg also has not paid over 700 hotels that are owned by their group in the Gulf Coast Region nor has he paid the Churches, maids, servants, landscapers, housekeepers, mothers and grandmothers who offered babysitting, fishermen, beauticians, barbers, single parents and many other poor workers below the poverty line because they are minorities.

This group recently visited BP's London Headquarters echoing that a comprehensive assessment should be given to show proximities to claimants that received payments and claimants that are minorities who have submitted claims.

After protesting Ken Feinberg's office this Thursday and Friday, September 22-23, 2011 at the Willard Building, in Washington, on Friday, the group will head to the Full Committee oversight hearing, "BOEMRE/U.S. Coast Guard Joint Investigation Team Report"at 11:00AM for the testimony of the Federal Government concerning the Oil Spill damages in the Gulf Coast Region at the US House of Representative's 1324 Longworth Building.
